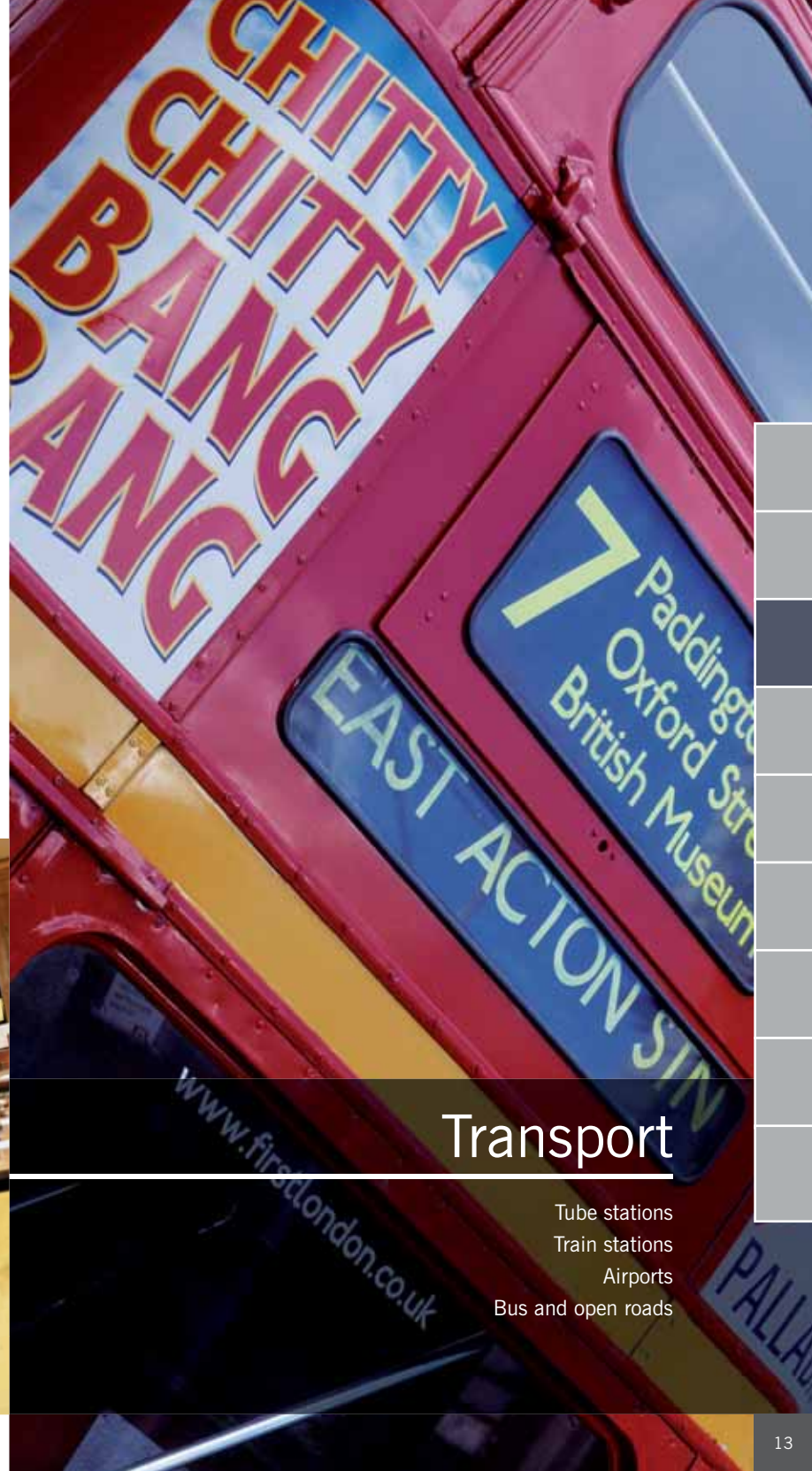

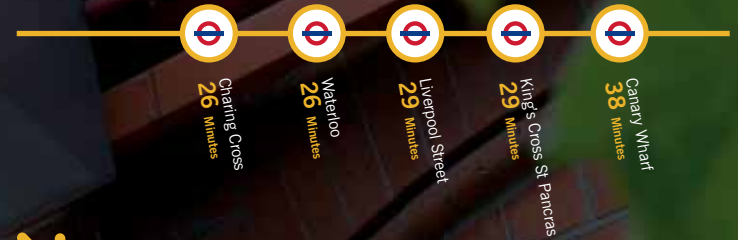

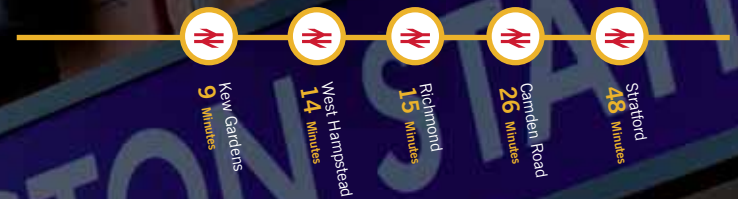
## Tube stations

West 3 benefits from excellent transport links to the City, West End and East London, with a choice of seven underground stations all within walking distance, namely East Acton, Turnham Green, Chiswick Park, Stamford Brook, Shepherd's Bush, White City and Wood Lane. All of these tube stations are located within 1.5 miles radius of Napier at West 3, providing access to the Central, District, Piccadilly and Hammersmith & City lines.



## Train stations

The nearest railway station is Acton Central, which is less than a mile from Napier at West 3. The station has a regular service westbound to Richmond which takes only 15 minutes and eastbound towards Stratford (48 minutes) on the North London Line. When the Crossrail service opens in 2017, the service will include a stop in Acton and provide further destinations that are accessible by train.

## Airports

London Heathrow is only 10 miles from Napier at West 3. Heathrow handles over 67 million passengers each year and offers a choice of over 200 domestic, European and international destinations.

London City Airport is 15 miles from Napier at West 3. It is a single runway airport for short take off and landing, serving 30 destinations with international connections to hundreds more.

## Bus and open roads

Transport to the City, the West End, and East London could not be more convenient from Napier at West 3. The M4, M1 and M25 are located only two, six and eight miles away respectively for easy access to the rest of the UK and Heathrow Airport. There are also numerous bus routes stopping at the end of Bromyard Avenue. For those who prefer to travel on two wheels, Ealing is part of the London Cycle Network that features over 2,500 km of signed routes throughout the Capital.

## Acton Green Common

Acton Green Common is a leafy city park, tucked away in the heart of Acton. Its facilities include a children's playground, tennis courts, sports pitches and a café, with a Grade II listed church an attractive focal point of the open space.

## Acton Park

A tranquil oasis just two minutes walk from Napier at West 3, Acton Park provides all sorts of facilities and features. These include tennis and basketball courts, football pitches, a play centre, bowling green and pavilion and acres of space for walking and jogging. The park is also an important site for nature conservation, with a large pond and wildflower meadow located in the southern part of the grounds.

## Avondale Park

Avondale Park combines formal gardens, small wildlife area and a separate area for five-a-side football, netball and tennis.

## Gunnersbury Park

Gunnersbury Park is 180 acres of parkland, historic and formal gardens and green open space. There are play areas and a number of sport facilities, which include rugby and football pitches, tennis courts, a bowling green and a pitch and putt golf course. The park also has many historic buildings from the time when it was a grand estate owned by Princess Amelia and the Rothschild family, as well as Gunnersbury Park Museum, which contains a wide range of local artifacts, fine art and photographs.

## Holland Park

Holland Park is the Royal Borough's largest park, with 22.5 hectares of gardens, children's play facilities, sports areas, large areas of woodland abundant with wildlife and a cafeteria. The park also provides facilities for tennis, football, netball and golf and cricket practise nets. Located within the park is the beautiful Japanese Kyoto Garden, which was donated by the Chamber of Commerce of Kyoto in 1991.

## Ravenscourt Park

Combining attractive landscaping and an impressive range of wildlife habitats across its 13 hectare open space, Ravenscourt Park is popular with both local residents and visitors. The park also has leisure facilities, which includes play equipment, tennis and basketball courts and an all-weather sports pitch.

## Royal Botanical Gardens

Just across the River Thames, the Royal Botanical Gardens at Kew is one of the world's leading botanic gardens and only 3 miles from Napier at West 3. The garden spans 300-acres and is very much an encyclopaedia of knowledge about the plant kingdom, with collections of living and preserved plants, plant products and botanical information.

## Springfield Gardens

Open to the public in 1935, Springfield Gardens contains facilities for both young and old visitors, including tennis courts, putting and bowling greens and a children's playground.

## Turnham Green

Separated in two by a small road, Turnham Green is a large public park in Chiswick High Road and is home to many different local community events throughout the year.
