BUSES

CYCLE

Reading mainline station has undergone a £897m upgrade and runs direct train services to key destinations such as London Paddington, Oxford, Bristol and Birmingham.


Shuttle buses go to Green Park from the town centre and the rail station every 10 minutes at peak times.


