



Double glazing in doors and windows provide further insulation, while more advanced building materials prevent problems such as damp. Roofs on new homes are also more secure as they are built on lightweight trusses rather than thick wooden beams.

The 10 year build warranty is a further guarantee of the quality you are buying with a new home.
