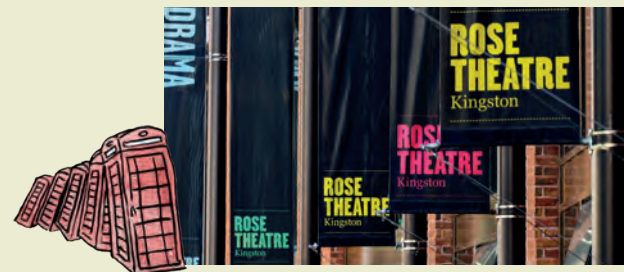


# A CULTURAL EXPERIENCE

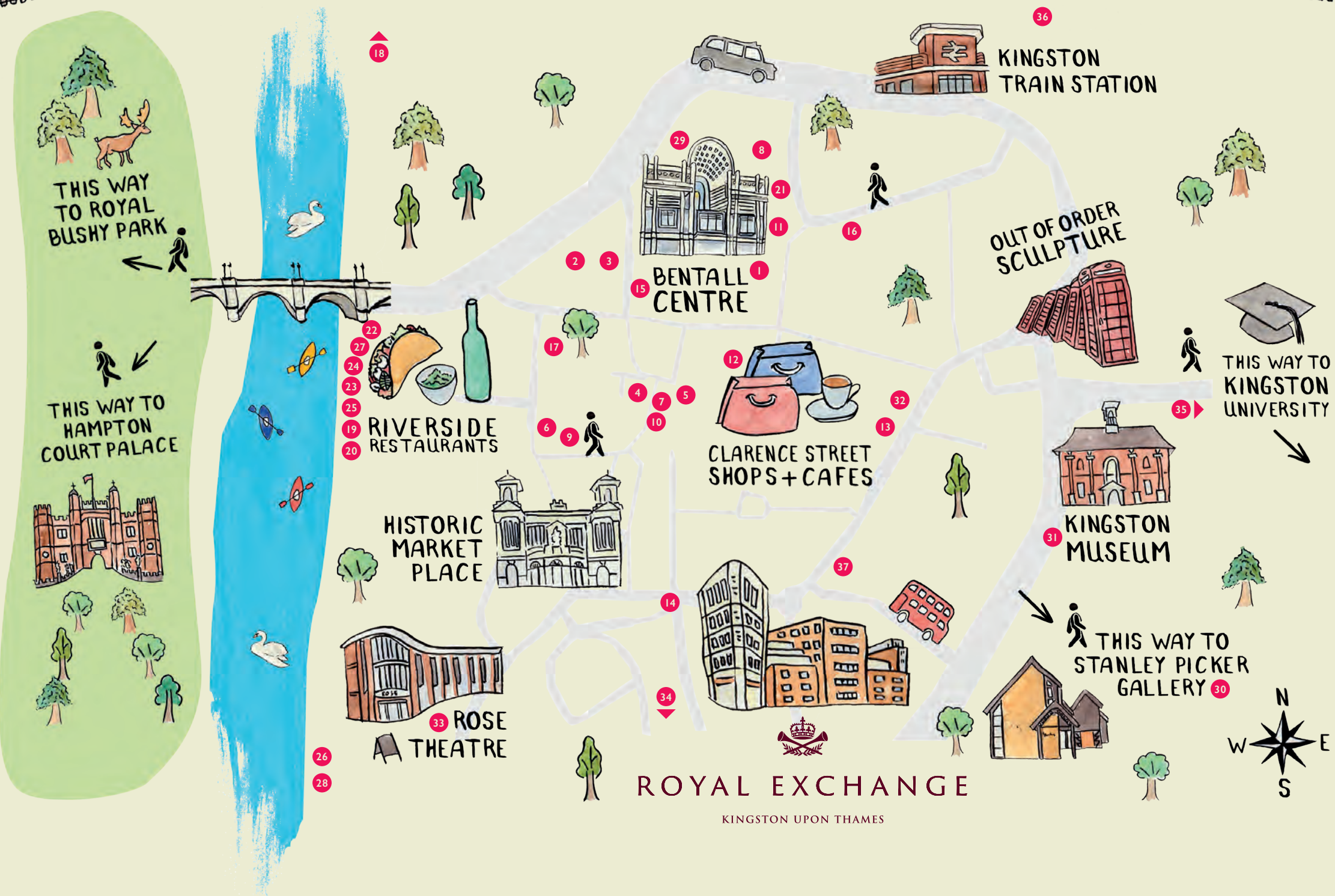
