


IDEALLY LOCATED.





FEATURES OF THE RIDE.

FITNESS TRAIL

1.5km circular loop through the avenue of lime trees for running and walking. It also features easy-to-use outdoor exercise equipment, positioned at regular intervals along the trail.

ECOLOGY AREA

Native trees and shrubs grow amid rough grassland to create a flourishing natural habitat and attract a rich diversity of wildlife.

THE SETT

Children's play area inspired by a badger sett with tunnels, dens, slide and climbing logs. A labyrinth path network will connect it all together in a fun and imaginative way.

HISTORIC LANDSCAPE.

THE STUNNING CENTREPIECE OF THE DEVELOPMENT
IS THE RIDE, A COUNTRY PARK WITH 34 ACRES OF NATURAL
GREEN SPACE.

This unique landscape was created in the late 1800s when large tree roundels were planted in Wycombe Abbey Park, forming an avenue that extended from Daws Hill House. These were later supplemented with a double avenue of lime trees planted in the early 1900s.

As a country park, it has a mix of open space and planted areas. There are orchards to enjoy, play areas to scramble over, lawns to recline on, and fields to run through. A multi-use games area and mini football pitches are available for sport, while community allotments will give you the opportunity to make new friends as the development grows. In addition to The Ride is The Dell, a natural green space that runs between the homes with trees, planting and water features.



DELICIOUS FLAVOURS.

FROM CAFÉS TO GOURMET CUISINE, THERE'S A DINING SPOT TO SUIT EVERY TASTE AND OCCASION.

High Wycombe is home to popular family-friendly restaurants such as Bill's, Pizza Express and Wagamama for a casual meal. Independent cafés offer a welcoming space for coffees, lunches and teatime treats; favourites include the Vanilla Pod Café Patisserie, The Front Room and Tin Kitchen. There are a number of pubs, such as The Squirrel and The Dashwood Arms, which are well-known for their food, and a feast of global cuisines: Thai, African, Sri Lankan, Indian, Japanese, Polish, Italian and American. For something different, try the stylish Lata Lata with its inventive and flavoursome menu.

Just a short drive from Abbey Barn Park is Marlow, where you'll find Tom Kerridge's two Michelin-starred The Hand and Flowers and one Michelin-starred The Coach, for delicious food in a relaxed setting. The Chiltern villages are also home to some popular eateries: there's the Apple Orchard Coffee Shop in West Wycombe, The Chequers Inn at Wheeler End and The Sir Charles Napier in Chinnor.



A THRIVING LIFESTYLE.

HIGH WYCOMBE IS A BUSTLING MARKET TOWN AND A FANTASTIC PLACE TO HAVE ON YOUR DOORSTEP.

Set in a steep valley, it has a pedestrianised Georgian high street as well as a modern mall, the Eden Centre, with dozens of high street brands, popular cafés and dining spots. The centre is also home to a gym, cinema, bowling alley and library.

The town itself is full of historic charm, with handsome period buildings and a 12th century parish church that is the largest in the county. There are regular markets, the Wycombe Museum and the Wycombe Swan theatre to visit, and a range of events and festivals to enjoy throughout the year, including the ancient ceremony of weighing the mayor. The historic Hellfire Caves, excavated in the 18th century and meeting place of the infamous Hellfire Club, are a fascinating attraction.

The Rye is the High Wycombe's attractive park, with two large playgrounds, café, lake and lido centre with two outdoor pools, gym, exercise studio and tennis courts. Discover your favourite place for a meal out, a tranquil spot for a picnic, and fantastic shopping and leisure activities.

DISCOVER NEW ADVENTURES.

ABBEY BARN PARK IS POSITIONED ON THE EDGE OF THE CHILTERN HILLS AREA OF OUTSTANDING NATURAL BEAUTY.

It's a varied landscape with chalk streams, ancient beechwoods, open commons, traces of historic settlements and charming villages with brick and flint cottages. It's all just waiting for you to explore, with lots of walking, cycling and horse riding trails meandering through the landscape.



LOCAL WALKS.

WEST WYCOMBE

The village of West Wycombe is the starting point for a number of circular walks. Routes take you through glorious beechwoods carpeted with bluebells and wildflowers. For stunning views over High Wycombe and the Chilterns countryside, climb West Wycombe Hill.



HUGHENDEN PARK AND DOWNLEY COMMON

Ideal for families, this easy-going walk takes you from the National Trust property Hughenden Manor along pretty woodland paths to the village of Downley and Downley Common, 22 hectares of open grassland, woods and ponds.



Three so-called Red Kite walks begin at the village of Studley Green and pass through beautiful Chiltern valleys. Enjoy panoramic views and look out for red kites overhead - they were re-introduced into the Chilterns in the 1990s and are frequently seen in the area.



MAKING CONNECTIONS.

DESPITE ITS RURAL FEEL, ABBEY BARN PARK IS IN AN EXTREMELY WELL-CONNECTED LOCATION.

You can reach the M40 by car in 7 minutes, the M25 in 13 minutes, and the M4 in 17 minutes. Heathrow Airport is just 22 minutes away.

High Wycombe rail station is 10 minutes away by car, or 16 minutes by bike, from where you can reach London Marylebone in 30 minutes. Travelling in the opposite direction, you can reach Oxford in 37 minutes by train. There are also two bus routes with stops a short walk from Abbey Barn Park that will take you into High Wycombe town centre.







HOW TO FIND

Abbey Barn Park.

Turn off the M40 at Junction 4. At the roundabout, exit onto Marlow Hill/A404. Turn right onto Daws Hill Lane. At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit and stay on Daws Hill Lane. Continue onto Heath End Road, then turn left onto Abbey Barn Lane. Abbey Barn Park is on your left.




