# GREAT LOCAL SPOTS TO ENJOY YOUR PICNIC

### PRIMROSE HILL

Primrose Hill is the ideal spot from which to enjoy panoramic views of the city. The crest of the hill is 63 metres above sea level and is one of six protected viewpoints in London, even the trees are kept low so as to not obscure the view.

Regent's Canal crosses the park
where you can take a boat trip past
the zoo or stroll the towpath from
Camden to Little Venice.



Take a moment of calm away from the bustling streets of the city.



One of London's many pocket parks, College Gardens is a triangular green overlooked by 19th century terraces and 20th century buildings. The landscaping includes Great Plane trees, a species common in the capital, and a historic drinking fountain.



#### GOLDERS HILL Park

Golders Hill Park is a beautiful landscaped park with a café, walled garden, tennis court and children's playground. It is also home to one of only two free zoos in London with a growing collection of rare and exotic birds and mammals.

#### HAMPSTEAD HEATH

A huge open space spanning 800 acres, consisting of many diverse areas such as Parliament Hill and the grounds of Kenwood House.

In between are wild meadows, woods and some spectacular views.

For hardy swimmers, there are open air bathing ponds.







#### CAMDEN SQUARE GARDENS

A quiet retreat, tucked away behind the hustle and bustle of Camden Road, Camden Square Gardens is popular amongst the locals with many frequenting here for lunches and picnics. Music fans may also know the area, as Amy Winehouse's iconic home overlooks the grounds.




## HYDE PARK


