Within a 1-mile radius of Grand Union, there are c. 8,500 students, making up on average 9% of the total population, versus 4% across London.

27% of international students in Wembley attended the university of Westminster in 2021/22. A further 10% of international student attended UCL.



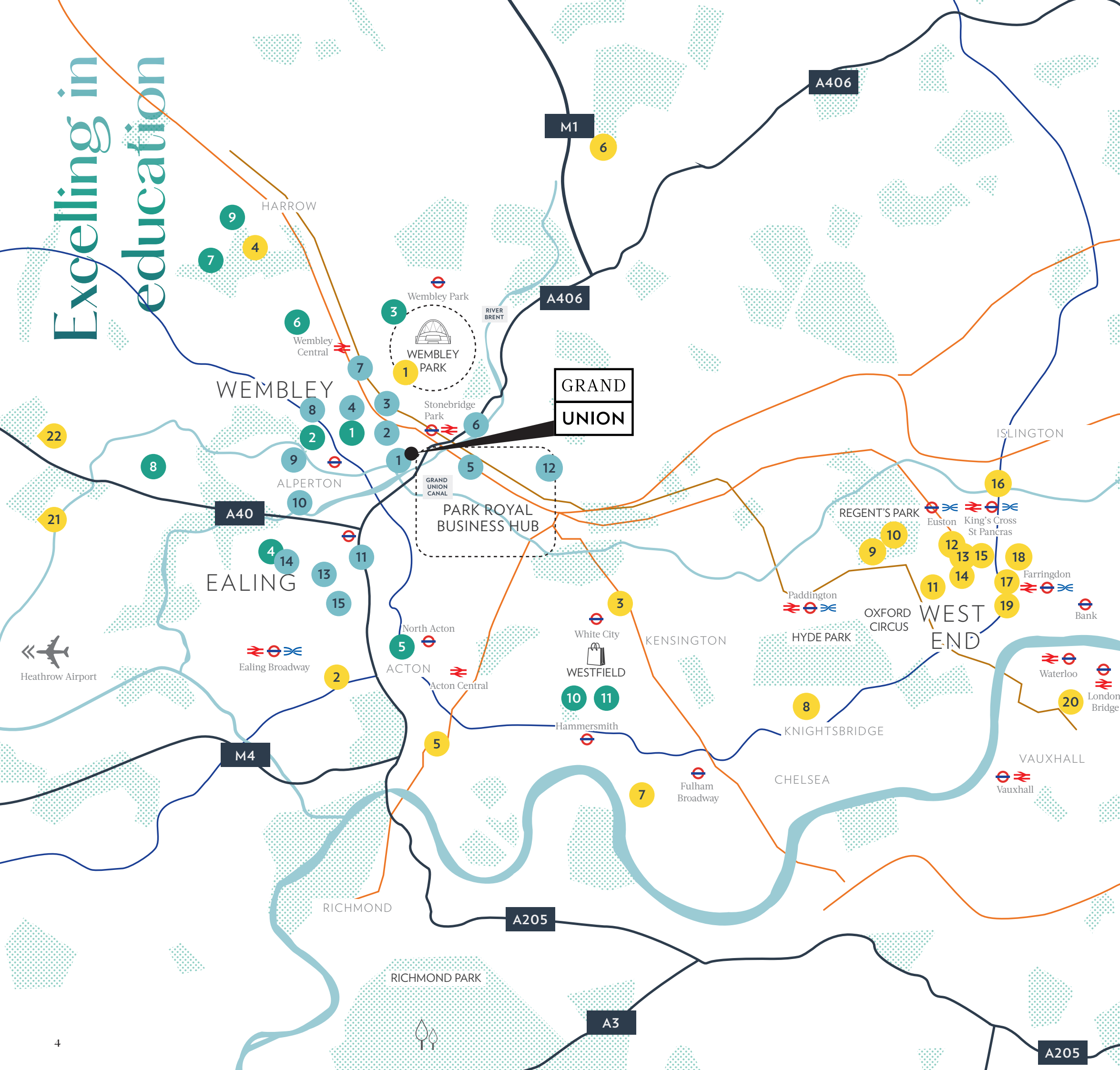
44% of international students in the local area are from China or the wider APAC region.

Peapods Early Learning Centre, an Ofsted rated 'Outstanding' chain of private day nurseries located across London, has opened its 6th nursery at Grand Union in Wembley.

What sets Peapods apart from many other early learning centres is its understanding of the impact of Artificial Intelligence and Robotics on future job opportunities and how they weave this into their curriculum.

With most curriculums focused on knowledge, and developments in AI enabling children to ask Alexa, Siri or ChatGPT anything they want to know at the click of a finger, Peapods felt it was important to establish a centre that focused instead on the development of skills, values and dispositions that are transferrable as they grow up.

Their qualified teachers share these through our much loved characters such as 'Perseverance through Terry the triceratops', 'Empathy through Daisy the Dog', 'Imagination through Dave the Dragon', and 'Independence through Kitty the Cat'.

Each of these dispositions are linked to the characteristics of effective learning which include playing and exploring, active learning, and critical thinking.

Peapods nursery has an open, light and airy feel, comprising three rooms. This includes the Baby Room, which will accommodate between 9 and 12 babies aged 6 months to 2 years, a Toddler Room with capacity for up to 20 toddlers for aged 2 to 3 years old, and a Preschool Room for 24 to 28 children aged 3 to 5 years old.

Peapods Montessori Day Nursery is open Mondays to Fridays, 8am until 6pm, excluding Bank Holidays.

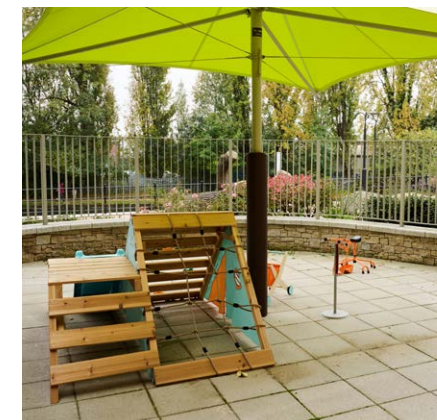

- In the 2020 GCSE and IGCSE results, students were awarded the higher of their centre-assessed grade and the statistically adjusted calculated grade. 86% of entries were awarded a 9 grade (1% point higher than the 2019 outcome) and 97.9% of entries gained an 8 or 9 (which are equivalent to the old A* grade). In the 2020 A level and Pre-U results, 64.6% of entries attained an A* grade at A level or the Pre-U equivalent D1 or D2, while 92.4% of entries achieved an A* or A grade and 98.4% a B grade or higher (or the Pre-U equivalent).
- The school has an active rowing club called the St Paul's Girls' School Boat Club which is based on the River Thames. The club is affiliated to British Rowing (boat code SPG) and has produced four British champion crews.

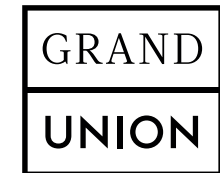

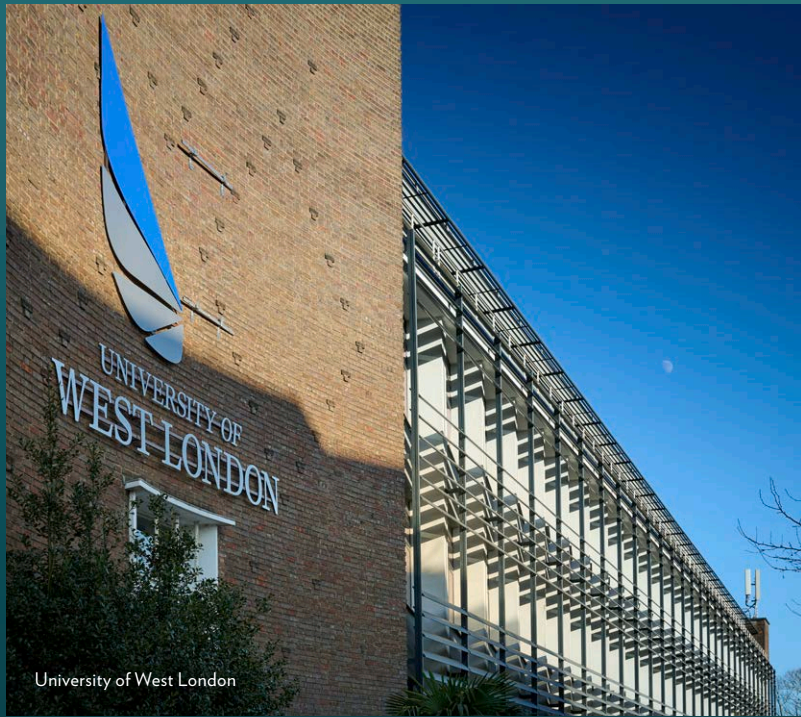
