

#### For shopping...

Working in the City or Canary Wharf? You can change easily from Paddington onto the Elizabeth line for easy connections to work or university.

## For exploring the canal...

Cycle or run along the Grand Union on the Grand Union towpath all the way to Regent's Park to visit London Zoo or the oldest outdoor theatre in the world. In less than 30 minutes\* you will arrive in Paddington Basin where you can find GoBoat, London Shell Co. and a Floating Pocket Park.

A short walk to three train lines to visit iconic sites such as Portobello Road Market, Big Ben, Houses of Parliament, Buckingham Palace, St Paul's Cathedral and Camden Market.
