
Situated in the heart of Watford, The Exchange offers a superb choice of schools in the town itself or the surrounding countryside.

With such a broad choice available, a home at The Exchange gives access to the full spectrum of educational opportunities, so every child and young person can thrive.



THE HABERDASHERS' GIRLS' SCHOOL AND HABERDASHERS' BOYS' SCHOOL

6 miles/9.6 km 🚔 18 mins by car

The two Haberdashers' schools are leading independent day schools for girls and boys aged four to 18. They share a leafy 100-acre campus in Hertfordshire, so provide the best of both worlds: single-sex education in a co-educational environment.

Both achieve excellent academic results and provide an array of extra-curricular activities, including orchestras, choirs, a wide range of sports, art, craft, language clubs, debating and drama.

MERCHANT TAYLORS' SCHOOL

4.1 miles/6.7 km 🚔 14 mins by car

Merchant Taylors' is one of the country's 'Great Nine' schools, founded in 1561 by the Merchant Taylors' Company. The school is academically highly successful but is also well known for its exceptional extracurricular provision, especially in music and sport, and its unique tutorial system with each boy assigned a tutor who looks after him throughout his time at the school.

Facilities are superb and give every boy the opportunity to find several things at which he, personally, can excel.

The school is situated on a stunning campus of 285 acres with easy access from the Metropolitan Line, and runs coaches from inner London to the home counties.

ETON COLLEGE

23.5 miles/37.8 km 🚔 35 mins by car

Founded in 1440 by Henry VI, Eton College is one of the most famous schools in the world. It is where 19 British prime ministers, including David Cameron and Boris Johnson, were educated.

Today it offers an exceptional educational experience for boys aged 13 to 18. The broad curriculum features 28 subjects, including 10 modern and classical languages. Life outside the classroom is equally rich with opportunities in drama, film, music, art, an extensive range of sports, and societies that attract leading figures as speakers.

HARROW SCHOOL

8 miles/12.9 km 🚔 25 mins by car

Harrow is one of the most prestigious public schools in the world, offering full boarding for boys aged 13 to 18.

Founded in 1572 under a Royal Charter granted by Queen Elizabeth I, the school is located in a leafy 300-acre estate in north west London. The superb facilities include an observatory, farm, golf course, fishing lake, tennis courts and swimming pool, as well as a theatre, concert hall and art studios.

As well as the original school, Harrow has established international schools in China, Thailand and Hong Kong, with more due to open in India, Japan and the USA.

PARMITER'S SCHOOL

2.9 miles/4.7 km 16 mins by bicycle

Parmiter's can trace its origins to the will of silk merchant Thomas Parmiter. He left property to endow six almshouses and 'one free school house or room' in Bethnal Green, East London. Over the years, it grew into a thriving boys' grammar school. In 1977, the Trustees decide to move Parmiter's to its current location as an all-ability, coeducational school.

Today it is a sought-after secondary school for boys and girls, and one of the highest performing state schools in the country by value added. It also offers a wide range of extracurricular activities, personal development programme, and excellent careers guidance.

WESTFIELD ACADEMY

1.8 miles/2.9 km 9 mins by bicycle

Westfield Academy is a popular and high performing secondary school, with exam results that are consistently amongst the highest for a non-selective school in the South West Hertfordshire area. In 2016, the school moved into brand new, purpose built premises, with excellent sports facilities including a dance studio, sports hall, badminton courts and 3G astro pitches.

As well as a full range of traditional GCSE subjects, Westfield Academy offers BTEC and other vocational courses, plus a rich programme of extracurricular clubs, activities and sports teams. Students also receive extra football coaching from Watford FC's coaches.

Originally a charity school founded in 1704 by local philanthropist Elizabeth Fuller, Watford Grammar School for Boys achieves high standards in academic study, sport, music, drama and other activities. watfordboys.org

WATFORD GRAMMAR SCHOOL FOR GIRLS

1.4 miles/2.3 km 8 mins by bicycle

Sharing its origins with the boys' school, Watford Grammar School for Girls has a long tradition of academic excellence, as well as many extra-curricular opportunities. It achieves superb results: 37% of all GCSE results were grade 8 or 9 in 2024.



DIRECTIONS FROM WATFORD JUNCTION STATION (PEDESTRIAN ACCESS ONLY) 4 MINUTES, 0.5KM

Exit the station and walk north-west along Station Road. Turn right onto St Albans Road and continue walking north along it. The Exchange will be on your right.

DRIVING FROM M25 12 minutes, 8km

Exit the M25 at Junction 19, using the two left lanes to turn onto the A41/North Western Avenue. At the roundabout, take the second exit onto the A41/North Western Avenue. Continue to The Dome roundabout and take the fourth exit onto the A412/St Albans Road. Drive down St Albans Road and The Exchange will be on your left.


DRIVING FROM M1 10 minutes, 4km

Exit the M1 at Junction 5, taking the A41 to Watford. At the roundabout, take the third exit onto the A4008/ Stephenson Way. At the next roundabout, take the second exit, then the third exit onto Radlett Road at the following roundabout. Take the first exit at the next roundabout onto Balmoral Road, then turn left onto the A412/St Albans Road. The Exchange will be on your left.
