




ENJOY THE WANDSWORTH WAY OF LIFE






Wandsworth has a thriving independent restaurant and café scene, as well as being home to plenty of trusted national chain eateries.





KING GEORGE'S PARK

MEANDER THE THAMES PATH & RIVER WANDLE

As well as enjoying walks along the Thames Path, you can also stroll along the Wandle Wander, a pleasant riverside path following the River Wandle through King George's Park.

The River Wandle flows northwards from Carshalton Ponds - its source - for nine miles to Wandsworth and finally joining the River Thames.

With its rich history, the Wandle was always a hive of industry – powering the local mills in the past. To this day it provides irrigation for market gardens whose produce ends up on the tables of Londoners, and provides the main ingredient for beer produced at the Ram Brewery.

The 20 kilometre (14 mile) Wandle Trail follows the route of the River Wandle from the Surrey Hills to the Thames at Wandsworth.






ARTS & CULTURE ABOUND

Wandsworth is blessed with a rich cultural scene, with everything from amateur dramatic groups and small local theatres to creative hubs such as the Battersea Arts Centre and large national institutions including the Royal Academy of Dance and the Royal College of Art.

A new 10-year cultural strategy has also been launched in Wandsworth, to put arts and culture at the heart of the local community and make it accessible and relevant to local people.

This ambitious strategy aims to establish Wandsworth as one of the country's leading examples of how to ensure arts and culture are integrally linked to the development of the borough.
